The first grade is made by 5 questions which weight 2 points each and one 5, total weights 15.

From the example above you can understand that 28.7 is obtained as

$(30*2+30*2+20*2+30*2+30*5+30*2)/15$ The second weight is made by two 2 points questions, plus one 3 and one 4.

From the example above $(30*3+27*4+27*2+28*3)/12$ which give 28.

The final grade is the first grade weighted 14, the second again 14 and the paper weighted 2.

The extra points and the laude L are used to refine the grade if they are above the average if they are below that suggest not to raise the grade.
